

Hello Neighbors,

The EPA / WA DOH recently issued a new requirement that a Lead Service Line Inventory (LSLI) of the piping materials on both sides of the water meters be submitted by Oct 16th, 2024 by all of the water systems. Because this was a new requirement, we were not aware of the submittal date or responsible party and had not prepared the report. King/NW Water also dropped the ball on this. As a result, we are now working on doing it but we are required by the State of WA to inform all of you that this report was not submitted. It turns out that all 30 of King Water's customers missed this deadline!

Your drinking water is safe and we are doing the necessary due diligence to remedy this violation. The official notice is:

We, Baby Island Heights Water Association, did not submit and are required to complete and submit a Lead Service Line Inventory (LSLI) to the State and make the inventory publicly accessible. Any lead service lines and certain other lines identified from LSLI will be required to be replaced to reduce lead exposure in drinking water. We did not complete our required LSLI, make it publicly accessible, and submit it to the State by the deadline of October 16, 2024. We therefore are not able to provide you with information on the service line materials at your service address yet.

We will be contacting some of you to ask you questions about your pipes. If you have any questions about this email, please hit reply. When we get it completed, we will post it on the website.
